General Requirements for a Bachelor's Degree

Bachelor, Bachelor of Arts (B.A.), Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.), Bachelor of Public Health (B.P.H.), Bachelor of Science (B.S.)

- A cumulative local GPA (<https://catalog.lapu.edu/undergrad/policy/min-gpa/>) of 2.0 and a 2.0 GPA in one's major. The major GPA includes all courses applied to the major requirements.
- A minimum of 120 semester credits (<https://catalog.lapu.edu/undergrad/policy/progress/>), 30 of which must be upper division (<https://catalog.lapu.edu/undergrad/policy/upperdivreq/>).
- Satisfaction of LAPU residency (<https://catalog.lapu.edu/undergrad/policy/residency/>) requirements by completing the following in residence:
 - At least 30 credits.
 - At least 18 credits of the major requirements, 15 of which must be upper division.
 - Any required courses designated as "Must be taken at LAPU".
- Completion of the LAPU Core (<https://catalog.lapu.edu/undergrad/programs/core/>) which includes
 - The general education curriculum requirements.
 - The LAPU Distinctives.
- Completion of the requirements of a major (p. 1).
- Submission of the Intent (<https://catalog.lapu.edu/undergrad/policy/intent/>) to *Graduate* form.
