The Organizational Leadership concentration provides students with skills, knowledge, and competencies essential for serving in leadership roles in for-profit, nonprofit, or governmental institutions. Domestic and multinational enterprises require leaders who possess the acumen to move organizations forward in a globally competitive marketplace. Students study theories of leadership and implement strategies designed to produce long-term sustainability with integrity and authenticity. The coursework prepares students to implement organization-wide change and position a firm to build competitive advantage.
